



Title of the Program: *"Awareness on CUET and Opportunities in Central Universities"*

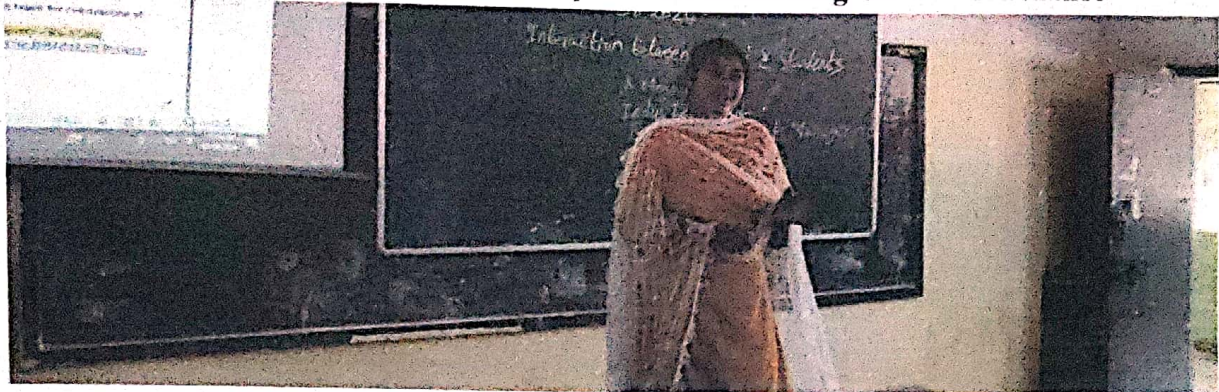

Title of the Program: "Skills Required for Marketing Careers in Finance"





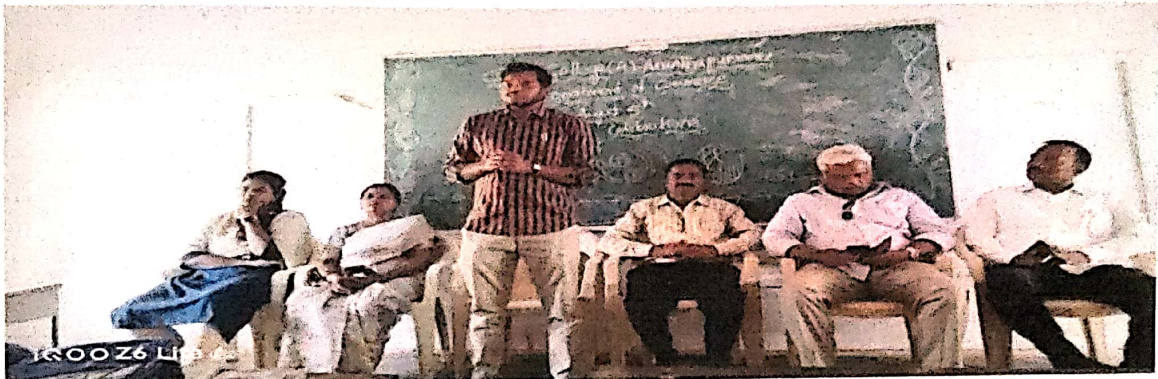





Title of the Program: *"Awareness on Chartered Accountancy Course"*

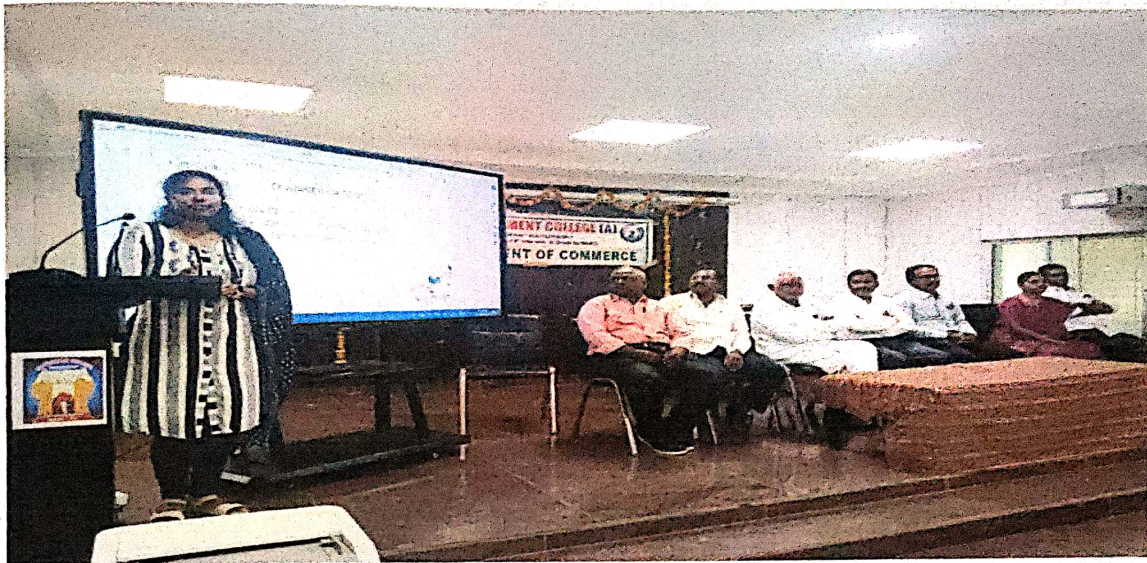





21.9.2024 Awareness on Opportunities for Degree students while doing degree

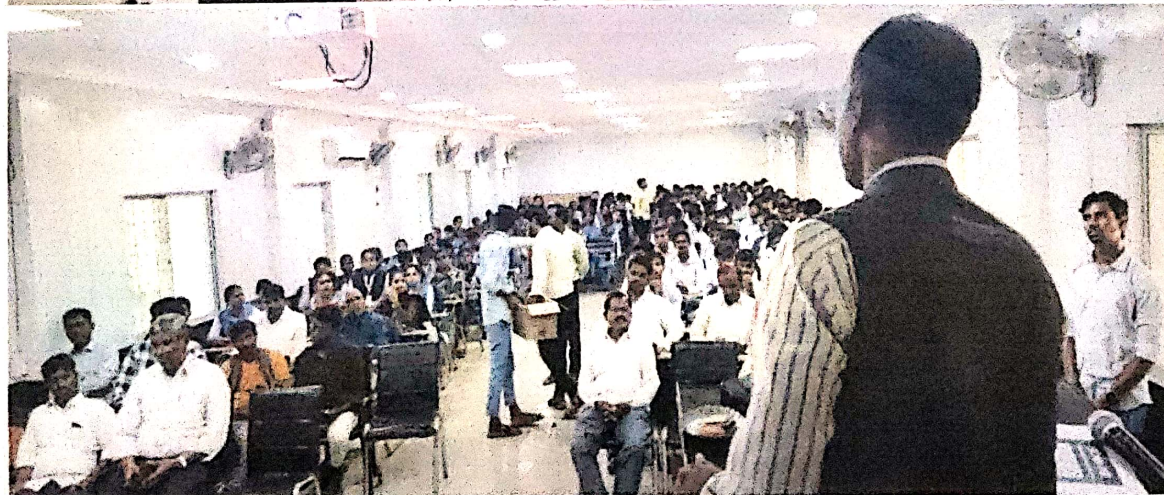


Dr. G. Ranganatham highlighted several advantages of CUET for students:

Date of the Program: 05.03.2025





Gist of Speakers:



Date: 30.08.2025






06.10.2025 Career Opportunities through GST 2.0

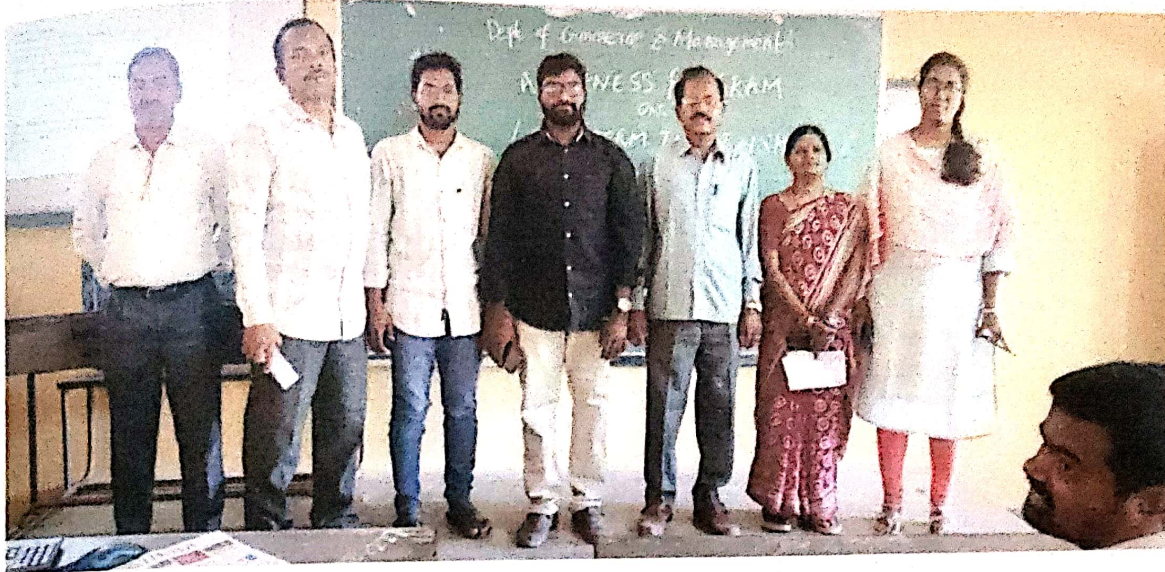




10.12.2025 Awareness to foster a strong culture of entrepreneurship and innovation among students and youth





15.12.2025 Advantages of Long Term Internship for career building

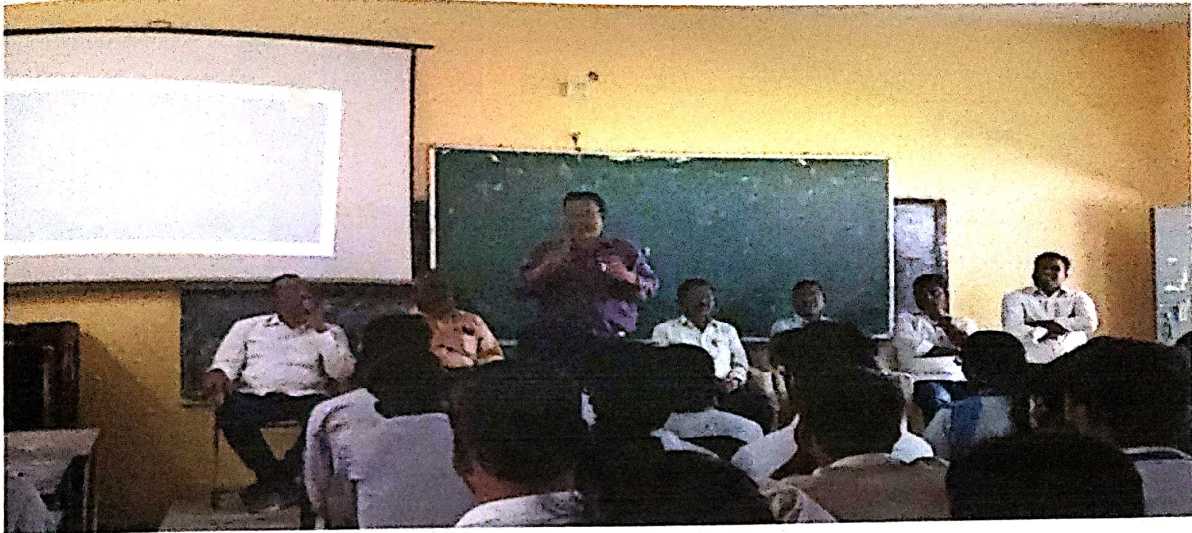





24-02-2026 Awareness on Stock Market Careers









Gist Report on Awareness Program – Staff Selection Commission Jobs

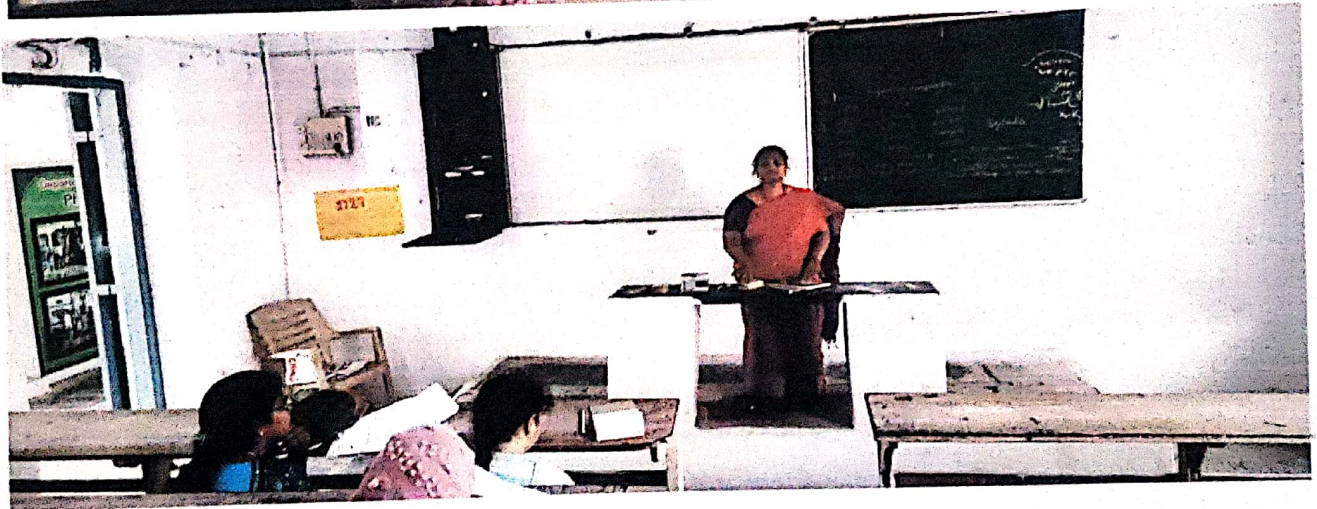

30-DAY DSC-2025 ENGLISH COACHING PROGRAMME Training from 20.6.2025 to 19.6.2025



REPORT :

1. Introduction

The Department of English, under the guidance of the Career Guidance Cell Member and Faculty of English, Dr. N.B. Shama Bharathi, along with other faculty members, successfully organized a 30-day intensive coaching programme for teaching aspirants preparing for the DSC-2025 (District Selection Committee) examinations. The programme was conducted from 20th June 2025 to 19th

July 2025 with the objective of equipping candidates with the necessary subject knowledge, pedagogical skills, and exam-oriented strategies.

Recognizing the growing competition and the importance of English proficiency in securing teaching positions, the department took a proactive initiative to design a structured and result-oriented coaching programme. The programme was carefully planned to address both conceptual understanding and practical application of English language skills required for competitive examinations.

2. Objectives of the Programme

The primary objectives of the 30-day DSC coaching programme were:

- To enhance subject knowledge in English grammar, vocabulary, and teaching methodology.
- To develop analytical and problem-solving skills required for competitive examinations.
- To improve communication and language proficiency among aspirants.
- To provide exam-oriented training with a focus on accuracy and time management.
- To build confidence among students to face competitive examinations effectively.

3. Programme Design and Inclusiveness

The Department of English launched this dedicated coaching programme with a comprehensive and inclusive approach. Though primarily intended for the students of the college, the programme extended its reach by welcoming **external candidates**, thereby benefiting a larger group of DSC aspirants.

All faculty members of the Department of English actively participated in delivering sessions, contributing their expertise across different areas such as grammar, vocabulary, and methodology.

The programme emphasized:

4. Day-Wise Syllabus & Training Schedule

Phase III: Sentence Structure (Day 11–15)

Advanced grammar topics were introduced:

- Articles
- Active and Passive Voice
- Direct and Indirect Speech

This phase helped students improve sentence formation and transformation skills.

Phase IV: Vocabulary & Writing (Day 16–20)

Focus was given to enhancing vocabulary and comprehension:

- Synonyms and Antonyms
- Idioms and Phrasal Verbs
- One-word Substitutes
- Reading Comprehension

This phase significantly improved students' language usage and interpretation skills.

Phase V: Methodology (Day 21–25)

Teaching methodology was emphasized:

- Methods of Teaching English
- Language Skills (Listening, Speaking, Reading, Writing – LSRW)
- Curriculum and Evaluation Techniques

This phase prepared aspirants for pedagogy-related questions.

Phase VI: Final Revision (Day 26–30)

The final phase focused on:

- Intensive revision of high-weightage topics
- Doubt clarification sessions
- Practice and reinforcement

5. Teaching Methodology Adopted

The programme adopted a learner-centered approach, ensuring active participation of students.

Various teaching methods were used:

- Lecture method for conceptual clarity
- Interactive sessions for discussion and doubt-solving
- Practice exercises for reinforcement
- Model question papers for exam preparation
- Real-time problem-solving techniques

Special emphasis was given to simplifying complex grammatical concepts and enhancing exam-oriented thinking.

6. Assessment & Practice Tests

To evaluate the progress of the participants, **five comprehensive practice tests** were conducted in alignment with the CBT (Computer Based Test) pattern of DSC examinations.

- **Practice Test 1:** Parts of Speech and Articles
- **Practice Test 2:** Tenses and Voice/Speech
- **Practice Test 3:** Vocabulary (Synonyms, Antonyms, Phrasal Verbs)
- **Practice Test 4:** English Methodology and Pedagogy
- **Practice Test 5 (Grand Mock Test):** Full syllabus (100 marks)

These tests helped students:

- Understand exam patterns
- Improve time management

- Identify strengths and weaknesses
- Enhance accuracy and speed

7. Student Participation and Response

The programme received an enthusiastic response from both internal and external candidates. The inclusion of aspirants from outside the college created a competitive and motivating learning environment.

Students actively participated in:

The coaching programme yielded significant positive outcomes:


- Improved understanding of grammar and language concepts

- Improved accuracy and speed in solving questions


The structured training and continuous evaluation played a key role in achieving these outcomes.
