College Profile:

Government College (Autonomous), Ananthapuramu, popularly known as Arts College, Ananthapuramu stands majestically on a sprawling 26 acres of land in the heart of the city. Established in 1916 with a few departments, it now boasts of as many as 28 departments. The student strength of about five thousand, UG programs in 38 combinations makes it a unique college not just in the Rayalaseema region but in the whole of Andhra Pradesh. The college has been accredited with an 'A' grade by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council three times in a row (NAAC). Impressedby the infrastructure and human resources available in the college it was given autonomy in 2016 paving the way for liberty in designing syllabi and taking decisions at the institutional level.



Academics:

As already mentioned, the College has 28 departments offering UG courses in 38 combinations. A few departments are offering PG courses as well. Some lecturers in the college are acting as research supervisors.

Urdu Medium: Keeping the interests of the linguistic minorities in view we are offering BA (with History, Political Science and Urdu Literature) in Urdu medium.

Faculty:

The USP of the college is the formidable teaching staff. As many as 150 lecturersteach in the college. Most of these are doctorates. Those that do not possess doctoral degrees are pursuing their Ph.D.s in different universities of Andhra Pradesh. However, all of our teaching staff have qualified either the National Eligibility Test conducted by UGC/CSIR or the APSET conducted by the Govt of AP.

Timing:

Keeping the special operating procedure of the government the college is being run in shift system. Classes for the Arts and Commerce will be conducted in the morning session whereas those for the sciences will be conducted in the afternoon session. The morning session commences at 8.45 and concludes at 1;00 The afternoon session will commence at 1:00 and conclude at 5:20. The duration of each hour is 50 minutes

Uniform:

For imposing discipline, the college has mandated that the students should come to college wearing uniform. A white shirt with thin blue stripes and sky blue-coloured trousers for men ana d white top with thin blue stripes and sky-blue pants (Salwar and dark blue Kameez) for women is the uniform fixed for UG students of the college. Sky blue coloured shirt and dark-coloured trousers, blue top, and dark blue pants (Salwar and dark blue Kameez) are the uniform fixed for the PG students.

Teaching Learning Process:

The College boasts of state-of-the-art laboratories and eClassrooms. Keeping in view the fact that teaching and learning in the 21c requires the use of Information and Communication Technology (ICT) the college has equipped itself with more than a dozen E classrooms. The laboratories in science departments are also well-equipped to make experiential learning possible.

Hostels:

The college has two student-maintained hostels; one for men and another for women. Bothe men's and women's hostels will be opened for the ensuing academic year 2022-23. The men's hostel has a capacity to house as many as 1800 men and the women's hostel can accommodate more than 300 women students. The hostels are adjacent to the college. They are equipped with reading rooms, spacious dining halls, and many other facilities.

Assessment:

Students will be assessed at the end of each semester. The semester-end exams will be conducted for 60 marks the aggregate of two Mid-Internal Exams, Student Seminar, and Attendance are taken to calculate the remaining 40 %. The assessment part is taken care of by the examination cell.

Library:

The library is the veritable powerhouse of the college. This is the place any of the teaching staff can be found if he or she has a leisure hour. Books that cannot be found in any other university can be found in the college library. The librarian and his staff are always ready to help the teachers and students with the books they want to read. Little wonder then the college library gets a footfall of nearly 100 to 150 during ordinary days and as many as 150 to 170 when the exams are around.

Since all the students are millennials and they do most of their reading on the screen, the library has got fully automated. Software called SAGE is used to make it hasslefree for the reader to find his favorite book from among 22,325 titles and 1,17,210 volumes. It is no exaggeration to say that the library is the sanctum sanctorum of the temple of learning which is known as Arts College, Ananthapuramu.

Admission Process:

The admission process is similar to that of any degree college within the state of Andhra Pradesh. The Andhra Pradesh State Council for Higher Education (APSCHE) conducts the admission process with a portal called Online Admission Module for Degree Colleges (OAMDC). The notification is given in June/July. Students who have passed Intermediate or its equivalent exam can apply for admission. Notification, registration, verification, allotment, confirmation and reporting at the college are various steps involved in the process.

Placement Cell:

The Jawahar Knowledge Centre doubles up as both a finishing school giving students the awareness of different areas which help them get jobs and also helps themget jobs by conducting job fairs on the campus.

NSS Units:

The college has as many as five NSS units with each unit having 100 volunteers. These five NSS units are headed by lecturers who have a strong commitment towards society. The men's units are headed by Dr Chalapathi, Lecturer in Economics, Sri Sekhar Lecturer in Commerce, Sri Nagabhushanam, Lecturer in History while the women's units are headed by Dr. Jayalakshmi Lecturer in Political Science and Smt. Vishnupriya, Lecturer in Botany.

National Cadets Corps (NCC):

The National Cadet Corps Unit of the college is the biggest strength of the college. Many students from the rural areas of Ananthapuramu and Kurnool districts use the NCC units of the college as a launch pad to find their way into the armed forces. Each unit has an intake of one hundred and sixty cadets.

The Boys Unit (Senior Division) is led by Lt. G. Ranganath, Lecturer in Commerce, and the Girls' unit by Ms. G. Chinnavenkatamma, Lecturer in Physics.

Women's Waiting Hall:

To make the girl students' stay in the college safe, comfortable and enjoyable a big room with basic facilities like a wash room and adequate furniture is allotted for girls.

Other Facilities on the Campus:

1. Playground:

Playground an essential part of any school or college. It is the playground where the students learn most of life's lessons like team spirit, cooperation and a host of others. The college has a playground of more than four acres which is popular with the students as well as others.

2. State-of-the-Art Gymnasium:

Even others come to the playground before and after the college hours. The crown jewel however is the state of the art gym which is better equipped than anywellness centre in the town.

3. Canteen:

At the centre of the college is the canteen. It is popular both with the students and the staff. One can have spicy samosas and a cup of tea at any time. Bumping into your friends and sharing a laugh with them at the canteen relieves from all work tension and gets you ready for the next task at hand.

4. Health:

The college has an effective strength of over 5000 students, 150 teaching and about 60 non-teaching staff. The health and well-being of all of these are given utmost importance. The college management does not take chances with the health of any of the students, teachers or other employees of the institution. Hence, a room has been designated as a dispensary. Any petty ailments or injuries given first aid in this room. In case of emergencies, we report the matter to the private nursing homes in the vicinity with which we have MoUs and they arrange for the ambulance.

5. Vibrant Alumni:

"The future of the nation is shaped in its classrooms". The classrooms of this college have done this effectively for the past six and hundred years. The result is the students who studied in this college have scaled great heights in the field of their choice. The college prides on the fact that the Presidents of the country, Chief Ministers,Judges of Supreme and High courts, and numerous IAS and IPS officers are among its alumni. 6. Anti-ragging Policy:

The college management maintains *zero-tolerance* against ragging. Any semblance of ragging on the college campus or in men's/women's hostels is viewed seriously. An anti-ragging committee comprising Sri B Nagabhushana, Lecturer in History as convener, Dr K Nagalakshmi, Lecturer in Geology, Dr P Giridhar, Lecturer in Zoology, Dr K Lakshmi Narayana, Lecturer in Telugu, Sri B Ravi, Lecturer in Mathematics, Dr T Sailaja Rani, Lecturer in Chemistry, Sri M Jabiulla, Lecturer in Physical Education and Sri A Jayaramappa, Lecturer in Physical Education in their capacity as members keep a hawk's eye on the movements of students. They takecomplaints and conduct inquiries. The committee conducts awareness programmes on ragging and its ill effects. They deal with an iron fist any attempt at ragging.
